If sociological concepts are to be treated with affection, each must be traced back to where it best applies, followed from there wherever it



seems to lead, and pressed to disclose the rest of its family.

International cooperation on the health of seafarers began many years ago. As early as 1921, an international convention regarding this matter was presented to governments of maritime countries for ratification. The First World Health Assembly, in 1948, recommended that WHO should establish, with the International Labour Office, a Joint Committee on the hygiene of seafarers. The first session of this Committee, held in 1949, defined the problems affecting the health of seamen and made a number of recommendations. In the opinion of this Joint Committee, the health of seamen called for international attention for a number of reasons. By the nature of his work, the seafarer is obliged to travel from country to

country and is exposed to great variations of climate and also to any disease that may be prevalent in the port of call. He may therefore become a carrier of disease, so that the protection of his health is of importance not only to himself and the other members of the crew but also to the populations of other countries he

visits. Yet, on account of the nature of his employment, it is difficult to provide the seafarer with the same standard of health care that is generally available to other sections of the population.
